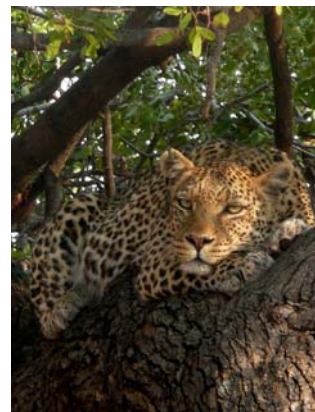

## Wildlife news



Guests have enjoyed some excellent cheetah sightings recently on the open plains between Hide 1 and Hide 4 – initially a lone female was spotted, but a few weeks ago she was seen on several different occasions accompanied by two cubs. We may also have leopard cubs nearby, as a lactating female was seen to the east of the lodge. She had pulled an impala ram up a tree whilst hyenas and jackals scavenged for scraps at ground level, and returned to feed on the kill for two consecutive nights.

A herd of elephants made a welcome appearance whilst guests were enjoying a recent bush dinner at one of our hides. We blew out all the lanterns and sat quietly watching the elephants by moonlight – magic!

You never quite know what you're going to see on a game drive at Tuli, and two of our more unusual sightings in the past few weeks have been an aardwolf digging for termites and a bushpig family. We often find aardvark droppings on the lawn at Tuli ... and now we've discovered his burrow within the lodge grounds, so hope to enjoy more regular sightings in future.
